Bring your experience and enthusiasm to a challenging and rewarding role of Traditional Healing Assistant at our Aboriginal Community Health Centre. We have 150 hours to offer working a flexible schedule with our Traditional Healing Program Coordinator assisting with scheduling team members, assisting with the application of traditional aboriginal teachings, assisting with the co-ordination and promotion of cultural activities, ceremonies and circles, assisting with planning of cultural activities and land-based activities to support Mental Health Wellness for clients, arranging educational sessions/workshops on Indigenous approaches to care and managing incoming referrals through an established intake process.

As a successful candidate your qualifications will include:

- Must be a minimum age of 15 years and not yet reached the age of 25 years on the first day of employment (persons with a disability as defined in section 10 of the Ontario Human Rights Code RSO 1990, c H.19 may be up to 29 years of age);
- Must be enrolled in secondary, or post-secondary institutions or within six months of graduation, who have reached the minimum age of 15 years and not yet reached the age of 25 years on the first day of employment;
- Must be a resident of Ontario
- Strong multi-tasking and prioritization skills with the ability to adapt to a wide variety of tasks and functions
- Proficiency in the use of computers and various software applications
- Ability to work both independently and within a multi-disciplinary team environment
- Ability to speak Cree or Ojibway is considered an asset
