We are issuing this Call for Nominations for the Misiway Milopemahtesewin Board of Directors (Misiway).

Misiway is an Indigenous primary health care organization. We follow the Indigenous Model of Wholistic Health and Wellbeing that addresses physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual wellbeing and integrates western approaches to health and wellbeing with traditional healing methods. We provide interprofessional primary health care, traditional healing and wellness, health promotion activities and children's mental health support.

Misiway is committed to Indigenous Health in Indigenous Hands and being a change agent, addressing systemic barriers that impact the lives of the people we serve.

It is an exciting time to be part of the Misiway Board of Directors. The Board is leading a vibrant organization at a time of immense change and opportunity.

Joining this board will be an excellent opportunity for community-minded individuals, with leadership ability. The board follows the Policy Governance Model. As a Director, your role will be to communicate with the communities we serve, set policy, monitor the Chief Executive Officer and ensure good governance.

Successful candidates will demonstrate a passion and commitment to the mission and values of Misiway. We are seeking disciplined team players, with keen analytical skills and the ability to be visionary. We prefer candidates who have previous board experience, but we are willing to extend opportunities to individuals who will commit to learning.

Misiway is currently seeking three directors for election. Therefore, we are seeking three additional directors. A reminder that the terms are for three years.

We are open to applications from all Indigenous peoples. Given the current make up of the board, we are particularly interested in candidates that are:

- Metis and/or Inuit;
- youth (between the age of 18-20) and/or elders
- and are male.

Each candidate must apply in advance and then the Board will conduct interviews. Based on the interviews and applications the Board will make recommendations for final election by the members at the AGM. There will be no nominations from the floor.

Interested candidates are required to:


